What is a Tenebrae Service? It's a service of Darkness or Shadows and Communion, one

## Prayer and Encouragement

***Job 19:25 "For I know that my Redeemer liveth, and at last he will stand upon the earth; and after my skin has been thus destroyed, then from my flesh I shall see God,"***



When I set about to have my knee replaced, I knew that I was entering territory that many of us have already traversed. As a tail-end Baby-Boomer, I am used to church friends saying about any medical procedure that they. 'had that done.' I'm fine with that. Goodness knows I am treated as special beyond what is good for me.

There was a difference with the knee replacement. Nearly everyone also offered advice: "Do the exercises", "Don't skimp on the therapy", "Therapy is key."

I realized that along with the offer to pray for me, people were eager to give advice and encouragement. People wouldn't usually give advice straightaway about a gall bladder or a biopsy. And, as much as we can be cynical about the value of free advice, this encouragement was well-meant, 100% true, and helpful.

So, what are we seeing here?

I think that when we know of a true cure, and a sure route to healing, we are naturally eager to share. We do not want anyone to suffer loss or trouble, and we will stand behind our advice about where help is found. What could be kinder and more human than that?

Which brings us to Job, and the verses from chapter 19, above. While Job experiences some of the worst advice from his friends; "It's your own fault, Job!", he has faith in the True Healer. His Redeemer Lives! Even if death intervenes, there will still be a grand experience of God's power.

Friends, take the faith of Job and the common-sense response to knee replacement, and put them together. We know Our Savior. He is shelter from the storm, life to the dying, comfort for the sorrowing. Translate your experience of God's Love into a witness that is simple and compelling. Share this truth with others. God has helped me, and I know he will help you. Trusting in Him will bring this all right in the end, and we will know healing beyond the present troubles.

# Your Witness—



## with Smart Phone Users by Don Gibson

**Did you know there are 3 billion smart phones in use today? Wow!** Most of us use them, and most people we talk with use one. Not all, but most. So here's a way to witness to people with smart phones. It's a smart phone Bible app, chock full of witnessing (and Bible study) tools. It's Free.

Go to the App Store or the Play Store and download the Gideon Bible App. Get V4.0. It has all the latest features and three great purposes built right in.

- 1) Reading
- 2) Bible study
- 3) Personal witnessing

I also use it sometimes to help prepare lessons and sermons. It's handy...right on your phone, whenever you want to read—even for just five minutes—and when a witnessing opportunity pops up. Those happen when we pray for opportunities. Then be looking.

**Get comfortable using your new app.** It's quick and easy to navigate. Look at "Helps" on the home page. There are three categories that take you to relevant Scriptures:

- 1) God's help in crisis
- 2) Help with life's problems
- 3) Godly living in today's world

Each has multiple sub-categories of Scriptures that shed God's light on how to deal with them. For instance, under "Help with life's problems," we see 34 categories, each with 2-6 verses to bring the reader into a Godly mindset about each category.

Again, it works very fast! So you can use it for yourself, but use it if you're witnessing to someone. You can ask people where they might be struggling. If they feel insecure, tap there and show them what God has to say about it. Maybe a friend is experiencing a bad day, and they say they are depressed. There are six verses at your fingertips.

The app also makes it easy to study the Bible about Godly living. So check it out. It's free! Then, pray for opportunities to witness. God's got plenty of people in our paths to help.

## OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD



Our Church filled and sent just under 1300 Gospel Opportunity shoe boxes in 2023. The countries that received our boxes were Uruguay, Peru, and Colombia.

In 1993, twenty-eight thousand shoeboxes were collected and sent. Today, two hundred and twenty million children have received a shoebox gift, a tangible gift of God's Amazing Love. Please be in prayer as we continue to support the OCC ministry.

Our packing party is always the 1<sup>st</sup> Thursday in November.

December 1<sup>st</sup> through December 4<sup>th</sup>, 2024, is the annual mission trip with Making Memories tours to Charlotte, NC, to process shoeboxes as they journey to over one hundred and seventy countries worldwide. If you are interested in this mission trip, registration and down payment are due in May.

***In March and April, we are collecting donations of girls hair accessories and jewelry for shoeboxes.*** All donations may be placed in the bin in the airlock by the water fountain.

### Gideons Expanding Ministry Partnership with Broadway

For years, The Gideons have approached churches to support The Gideon ministry in four primary ways:

1. *Prayer*
2. *Qualified Gideon membership*
3. *Use of Gideon Cards*
4. *Offerings and mission gifts*

The Gideons still have those ministry relationships with churches. Thank you. It's working.

In recent years, **GIDEONS HAVE EXPANDED THE MINISTRY** and Broadway is a part of that. Instead of just Gideons and our Auxiliary wives distributing God's Word...**YOU ARE.**

**Gideons cards** -The Gideons have been supplying cards and a display unit for Broadway for many years. It's on the wall beside the big bulletin board in the airlock. You've been using Gideon cards for years. But Gideons have expanded the card selection in recent years, providing cards for many more occasions to use them. That increases their use. It

increases the number of people reached with cards and those who see Scripture on them. That is an outreach for Christ. Plus, you help fund Gideon Scripture distribution when you send Gideon cards. Three basic cards are in the airlock. To select others, go to "[sendtheword.org](http://sendtheword.org)". Take a look!

**Gideon Bible app** - over 2,000 languages - from around the world. Go to The App Store (iPhone) or to the Play Store (Android) to type in the "Gideon Bible app." Everyone can download the app to have the entire Bible on their smartphone. It also has all the study help and the plan of salvation pages, as in our New Testaments with Psalms and Proverbs.

**Friends of Gideons** (launched 2014) - There are no qualifications. **Anybody can become a Friend of the Gideons.** It's a way everyone can partner with other Christians and Gideons to witness for Christ. Your role is prayer, financial gifts, and purchasing and distributing New Testaments, just as Gideons and Auxiliary do. To buy small new testaments to hand to people as a witnessing tool, go to "[friendsofgideons.org](http://friendsofgideons.org)." They have study help and a "Plan of Salvation" page on the inside front and rear covers.

**Lifebook, created especially for church youth.** It's youth evangelizing youth—their friends. The Gideons provide free of charge supplies of **The Lifebook**, so our youth can learn to witness for Christ by handing copies to their friends.

# Gideons Expanding Ministry Partnership with Broadway

**Why? Gideons are not permitted to take God's Word onto public school property in most states, including Ohio.** But students can give Lifebooks to their friends anywhere, which contain the Gospel and explain how God's Word helps young people deal with youth issues and pressures. Church youth leaders or pastors can go online to order. The Gideons suggest ordering at least ten copies per youth member so each can offer their friends a supply—100 Lifebooks per box. Again, Lifebooks are at no cost to the Church. The Lifebook website offers Lifebooks and multiple training videos on how to witness using these Lifebooks. Go to "[thelifebook.com](http://thelifebook.com)."

**Conversations** - Now Gideons is offering the **Conversations** program to adults and youth—to learn how to witness Christ to others personally. The Gideons have certified members who will lead a 2-3 hour workshop for Church members on how to witness Christ with others. Note the program name: "Conversations". Broadway members will learn not to "preach" salvation to others but to "dialogue" with others about how and why to come to Christ. Nothing pushy. It's learning to listen, ask questions, and use Scriptures relevant to the dialogue. It's a proven program, and the Tuscarawas County Gideons are excited to introduce it to Broadway and other churches. Pastor Harley has already asked us to arrange scheduling a session.

**Membership** - Of course, the closest way for any Church to stay connected to The Gideons and its many programs is for qualified business and professional men and their wives to become Gideons themselves. Broadway already has Gideon members—but we hope for more. On the website, you can read about our various ministries and why God would lead qualified men to join. It has easy-to-understand explanations and videos. There are membership qualifications. Men who do not qualify can still have an active ministry role in partnership with The Gideons by joining Friends of Gideons (above). Go to "[invite.gideons.org](http://invite.gideons.org)."

Designate your gifts to the Gideons for the month's mission by putting the amount on the monthly mission line on your tithing envelope or writing **Gideons** on the memo line on your check.

Several times through the year, our Special Friends receive gifts of candy, devotionals, prayer shawls, small items they can use, or decorations for their door or room. Members of the group and Pastor Harley personally deliver the gifts.

The Broadway Mission Workers hold an annual Christmas Bake Sale as their primary fundraiser. But there is another way to support this group: by purchasing greeting cards. Many cards are made from used greeting cards, which people have donated. Sometimes, boxed cards are also available for a very reasonable price. The cards are available in the Library. 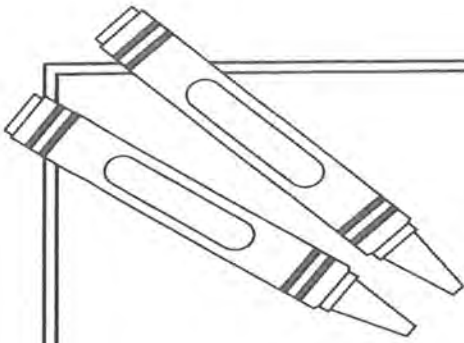

## Your Witness—“Your Vision...God’s Glory” - by Don Gibson

**Question:** Our waitress, cashier, neighbor, fellow team employee, family member.

What do they all have in common? OK...our answer/your answer? \_\_\_\_\_

**And God’s answer?** *“The Lord is not slack concerning his promise...not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.”* **2 Peter 3:9** God is calling all to be saved from sin, and to grow in Christ as a servant of righteousness. *“Being then made free from sin, ye became the servants of righteousness.”* **Romans 6:18**

**Where would you and I fit in?** Witnessing for Christ in our daily lives. What an honor. What a treat to share Christ’s message with others—to hear people share their questions, fears, and doubts—then have the opportunity to show them an answer from God.

**But one might say,** “I’m afraid to do that.” or “I’m not sure how.” OK. That’s fair. But if we take that to God in prayer, asking Him to show us, teach us, encourage us. **Do we really think God can’t do that?** He can, and He will. That’s in his job description.

**Here’s the key.** “Father in Heaven, **give me the vision** to be your servant of righteousness. Teach me through your Word. Put me in a small group, a Sunday School class, or a relationship with a friend or pastor who will teach me or lead me to the opportunity to learn to be Christ’s servant—with joy and confidence.”

**So, the key is catching the vision of being God’s servant.** Let’s relax the world’s focus and ask for God’s focus. Ask for the vision. It’s God’s will. God gives us His grace to do it because we could never do it using our own desires and abilities. God provides desire. God provides opportunity. God offers the way. We submit.

**Galatians 1:3-4** *“Grace be to you and peace from God the Father, and from our Lord Jesus Christ, Who gave himself for our sins, that he might deliver us from this present evil world, according to the will of God and our Father.”*

It takes the Spirit of God to give us the vision and lead us in the way. That’s a super prayer request. Just pray about it. Seek Scriptures about it. God leads. God provides.

**Romans 8:14** *“For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.”*

So here’s my suggestion for the answer in the first line above. Pray that God gives us the vision to be His servants of righteousness. **It’s a new focus for 2024.**
